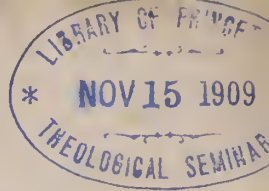

Members of the first class are required to exhibit original compositions once in two weeks; those of the second class once in three weeks; and those of the third class once in four weeks.

VACATIONS.

There are two vacations, one from the Wednesday preceding the second Thursday in May, of six weeks. One from the last Wednesday in September, of six weeks, and a recess of two weeks in February.

EXPENSES.

Board may be obtained at various prices from \$1,25 to \$1,75 per week. Fire wood from \$4 to \$6 per annum, Washing \$8. Each Student pays to the Seminary, for the general expense fund, \$10 per annum.
